In June, We Celebrate Homeownership

Florence, KY – June 21, 2022 – The Northern Kentucky Association of REALTORS® (NKAR) and the Northern Kentucky Multiple Listing Service, Inc. (NKMLS) reported today that home sales in May 2022 are -8.36% lower than in the same month of 2021. The average sale price is on the rise, by 12.37% in May 2022 over May 2021. Working with a rather stagnant market due to the continuously rising mortgage rates the total dollar volume of home sales – was up by a mere 2.98% in May 2022 (\$192,083,532) over May 2021 (\$186,533,026). It is notable that inventory shortages persist which in turn may reflect positively on the sold price of a home, but not affect the total dollar volume as directly.
