Average and median residential sold prices were higher by 7% and 6% for January 2023. Homes are still selling relatively quickly with an average of 32 days on market. NKY total \$ volume is down -21.85% for 2023 v. 2022, but an entire year remains to reap the rewards of transactional real estate in Northern Kentucky!
